ABOUT THE ROLE

As a community builder and leadership coach of MOTG you will offer and further develop the *Che Amigo* program, "Leadership in my Community". The purpose of these 4 months is to introduce residents, volunteers and local Greeks to this program. In this program people learn to develop their own leadership qualities and to set up their own projects in favour of the community. Your job is to organise, conduct and train the people with setting up their projects. Ultimately, you write a project plan to advise on how we can implement this program in a sustainable, effective and practical way in the long term, so that the local community can take over and continue to run the program independently.

This job is unpaid, we will cover your living expenses (accommodation, rental car, consumption), meaning there is no salary.
